The Netherlands Willing to Try Suspects of Rwanda Genocide

ARUSHA — The Netherlands, Belgium and France are prepared to try suspects of the 1990's genocide in Rwanda in their own courts, announced the Rwanda-tribunal (ICTR) in the Tanzanian city of Arusha today. According to the ICTR the countries agreed to try suspects living in their jurisdictions in a court of law. Norway earlier confirmed its readiness to act in a similar way.
